Scripture	Summary	Date
Revelation 6-11	The events leading up to the destruction of Jerusalem in 70 AD	Up to 70 AD.
Revelation 12	Events of the birth of the church and the church's flight to Pella shown in signs, including Christ's birth.	66 AD
Revelation 13	The Two Beasts. Foresees Domitian's Reign as the Beast, "Nero back for the pit", and the Imperial Cult as the False Prophet.	Ended in Sept. 96 AD
Revelation 14:1-5	First-fruits church. The original generation of believers has gone on to be with the Lord. The "fruit that remains" is the church through the ages.	Circa 100 AD
Revelation 14:6-13	The three angels. The Gospel will now spread throughout the world, Babylon will fall, and those who submit to Emperor worship while it still remains will receive the same fate as it.	...
Revelation 14:14-20	The two harvests, and the WinePress of His Wrath. Seen in the Seige of Betar in the Second Jewish Revolt, during which over 500,000 Jews were killed in the city of Betar, just outside of Jerusalem in 135 AD.	132-135 AD
Revelation 15-16	The Seven Bowls of Wrath. Seen as the final wrath against Babylon, which is Rome. The purpose was the breakdown of the empire, and was witnessed in the "Crisis of the Third Century", resulting in the empire being broken up into three warring factions, and the loss of the Principate.	250-271 AD
Revelation 17-19	The Fall of Babylon, the Great Harlot. Seen as Rome, the spiritual power of Rome was	Circa 300 AD

	broken through the conversion of its emperor to Christianity. Constantine's conversion led to the legalization of Christianity and the end of the outward persecution of the church.	
Revelation 20:1-6	The Millennium. Foxxe's book of martyr's records no martyrs for 1000 years following the Edict of Milan in 313 AD. Literally, the murderer himself, but not all demons, were bound and locked into the pit until the thousand years were up.	Circa 313 AD
Revelation 20:7-10	Persecution begins again in the church against John Wycliffe. This was followed by the martyrdom of John Huss in 1415. By the of 1522, when Martin Luther posted his 95 theses, the “renaissance”, or “rebirth of the dragon from the pit”, was in full swing, with the rebellion against the church, the separation of “knowledge, science, and understanding” from the Word of God, and the promotion of secularization. Since this time, the working of the dragon has been to subvert the Word of God with things such as Evolution and Humanism, and ultimately to deceive the nations and bring them again to ultimately attack the church. In the period of this “short time” is the evidence, over the few centuries, of the coercion of the nations towards this end, and as Israel is now a nation and sin and morality continue to degrade, it is only increasing.	1371-1522 Ongoing Will end with the Gog Magog war, and the judgment of the dragon. This period ends, according to Ezekiel 39:28-29 with the salvation of all Israel, after much trial.
Revelation 20:11-15	The Second Coming, the appearing of the Lord in the Great White Throne Judgment seat. Corresponds to Matthew 24:29-31.	“Day and Hour Unknown”*
